- Programming - Drag and Drop (Scratch, Tynker, Alice etc.)

- 3D Design
- Maker Technologies

Teams can use their own laptops, iPads and other digital hardware to complete the challenges.

TIME	What happens?
9AM	Teams arrive, register, hand in media release forms and move to the area for the competition they have entered. At this point they setup their equipment and prepare themselves for the competition.
9:30 AM	Contestants gather and the judges in each category will outline the "mission" for each challenge. The challenge will be based around the theme for the year.
10AM	Teams plan their response then work together to complete the one and half hour challenge (movie making/ mine craft are two hours).
11:30AM	The teams complete the challenge Adjudicators judge the entries to award places and prizes Teams have lunch (brought with them). Sausage sizzle will be available.
12:30PM	Awards ceremony and presentations, spot prizes. Category awards and overall (from primary and intermediate) winners.
