- Do not print the tasks, as they will be marked from your screen. This will allow you freedom to use colour in your designs.

Scenario

The Internet is a vital and wonderful resource that can encourage young and old to explore, learn, interact, create and contribute. With over a billion people using the Internet, it is also important that we are aware of safety issues and how we can keep ourselves safe online.



You have been asked to design three publicity documents about Internet safety.

Judges will be looking at:

- Design elements
- Layout (proportion, harmony, sequence, balance)
- Readability and suitability
- Use of colour
- Visual appeal and originality
- Consistent design
- Following instructions

Task One: Two Page Newsletter

Design a two-page newsletter aimed at parents about Internet safety.

The overall design of the newsletter should incorporate a creative and effective use of alignment, proximity, proportion and harmony of text, white space and graphics. Consider the use of font size and style, borders, columns, bullets, reverse text, and shading, etc.

Use at least four articles. You decide on the articles, article heading and the location/order of each article within the newsletter. You can choose how many images you use.
